Brief Description of Item(s) and Use: This contract will provide the San Antonio Public Library Department with a subscription for access to Reference Solutions Database which provides information on US and Canadian businesses. The database covers approximately 70 million businesses in the US, including closed businesses and is updated weekly. The Reference Solutions subscription includes the US business, New Business, Historical Business, US Jobs, Healthcare, Canadian Business, Consumer Lifestyle, US White Pages, New Movers/Homeowners, Canadian Residential, and Data Visualization modules. Library patrons can access the the database 24 hours a day, seven days a week from any San Antonio Public Library or home/office computer. These items are being purchased as Sole Source according to the provisions of Texas Statutes Local Government Code 252.022.07. No other source can supply the items listed nor can any comparable item fulfill the same requirements. Vendor acknowledges, with his/her signature, that all items offered are considered a Sole Source.
