The WHO has selected 21 films to screen at Mission Marquee Plaza in 2022. The WHO is recommending to create an Informal Bid (RFO) for the 21 films @ \$550 each for 5 years, total amount \$57,750.00. CCDO is requesting Film licenses for Travis Park 'Movies by Moonlight' series. The CCDO has 7 films to screen at Travis Park in 2022. For the 7 films at \$665 each for 5 years, total amount \$25,000.00.
