APPROVING THE FOLLOWING CONTRACTS ESTABLISHING UNIT PRICES FOR GOODS AND SERVICES FOR AN ESTIMATED ANNUAL \$211,575.00, **INCLUDED** COST **OF** IN THE RESPECTIVE DEPARTMENT'S FY 2022 ADOPTED BUDGET: (A) INTERVET INC., VETERINARY DBA MERCK ANIMAL HEALTH, **FOR** PHARMACEUTICAL SUPPLIES FOR THE ANIMAL CARE SERVICES **DEPARTMENT**; **INFOUSA** MARKETING, INC., **(B)** SUBSCRIPTION TO THE REFERENCE SOLUTIONS DATABASE FOR THE SAN ANTONIO PUBLIC LIBRARY; AND (C) SWANK MOTION PICTURES, INC., FOR MOVIE LICENSING FOR THE CITY'S WORLD HERITAGE OFFICE AND THE CENTER CITY DEVELOPMENT AND **OPERATIONS DEPARTMENT.**

WHEREAS, the City is able to obtain significant savings by purchasing various materials and services on an annual contract basis; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance approves contracts with (A) Intervet Inc., dba Merck Animal Health, for veterinary and pharmaceutical supplies for the Animal Care Services Department; (B) InfoUSA Marketing, Inc., for a subscription to the Reference Solutions Database for the San Antonio Public Library; and (C) Swank Motion Pictures, Inc., for movie licensing for the City's World Heritage Office and the Center City Development and Operations Department; and

WHEREAS, the bids submitted by Patterson Vet Supply failed to meet the City's specifications and/or requirements for veterinary and pharmaceutical supplies; and

WHEREAS, the Texas Local Government Code indicates that competitive bidding is not required under section 252.022(a)(7)(A), which provides for any items that are available only from a sole source of supply; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance approves one low bid contract and two contracts procured on the basis of the sole source exemption; and

WHEREAS, all expenditures will be in accordance with the applicable fiscal year's budget approved by City Council; **NOW THEREFORE**:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The following bids and offers to furnish the City with goods and services on an annual basis as shown on the attached bid tabulation sheets are hereby accepted, subject to and contingent upon the deposit of all required bonds, performance deposits, insurance certificates and

endorsements: (A) Intervet Inc., dba Merck Animal Health, for veterinary and pharmaceutical supplies for the Animal Care Services Department; (B) InfoUSA Marketing, Inc., for a subscription to the Reference Solutions Database for the San Antonio Public Library; and (C) Swank Motion Pictures, Inc., for movie licensing for the City's World Heritage Office and the Center City Development and Operations Department. The bid tabulation sheets are attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Exhibit I**.
