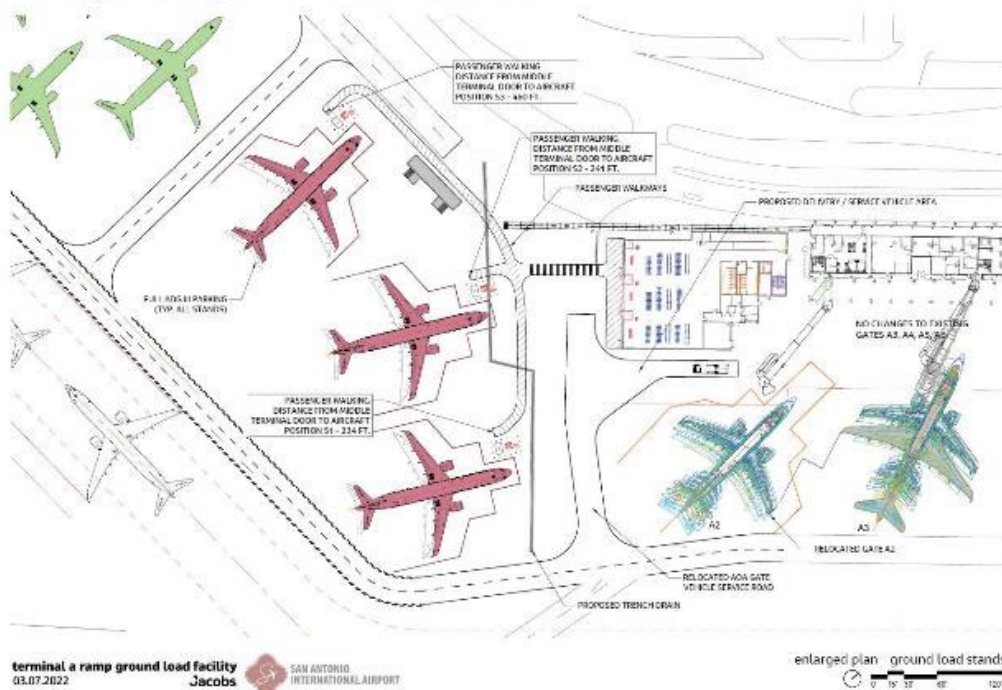

Design & construct a ground-loading facility with 3 gates, holding rooms and associated systems.

Project includes an adjacent aircraft parking ramp to Customs Area.

Accommodate domestic and international flights.

Requesting \$750,000 to initiate programming and authorize design up to 30% design documents.
