## **ORDINANCE**

APPROVING A CONTRACT WITH STANDARD FUSEE CORPORATION TO PROVIDE RED BURNING FLARES FOR THE SAN ANTONIO POLICE DEPARTMENT AND THE SAN ANTONIO FIRE DEPARTMENT FOR AN ESTIMATED ANNUAL COST OF \$300,321.00, INCLUDED IN THE RESPECTIVE DEPARTMENT'S FY 2022 ADOPTED BUDGET.

WHEREAS, the City is able to obtain significant savings by purchasing various materials and services on an annual contract basis; and

WHEREAS, Standard Fusee Corporation submitted the low bid for red burning flares for an estimated annual cost of \$300,321.00; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance approves a contract with Standard Fusee Corporation beginning July 1, 2022 and ending June 30, 2025, with the option for the City to renew for two additional, one-year periods; and

WHEREAS, all expenditures will be in accordance with the applicable fiscal year's budget approved by City Council; NOW THEREFORE:

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

**SECTION 1.** The bid submitted by Standard Fusee Corporation to furnish the City with red burning flares for an estimated annual cost of \$300,321.00 as shown on the attached bid tabulation sheet is hereby accepted, subject to and contingent upon the deposit of all required bonds, performance deposits, insurance certificates and endorsements. The bid tabulation sheet is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Exhibit I**. Copies of the bid are available for inspection in the offices of the Purchasing Division of the Finance Department.

**SECTION 2.** Funds will be encumbered upon issuance of purchase orders, and payment is authorized to Standard Fusee Corporation. All expenditures will be in accordance with the Fiscal Year 2022 budget, and such other appropriations necessary to fund the contracts through its term as evidenced by subsequent ordinances.

**SECTION 3.** This ordinance is effective immediately upon passage by eight affirmative votes; otherwise it is effective on the tenth day after passage.
