ORDINANCE

AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF FUNDS FROM THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$25,000.00 AND AN IN-KIND MATCH NOT TO EXCEED \$6,251.00 FOR THE "OPERATION SLOWDOWN" GRANT PROGRAM, AND ESTABLISHING A BUDGET WHICH WILL RUN FROM JUNE 7, 2022 THROUGH JUNE 21, 2022.

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WHEREAS, the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) has an "Operation Slowdown" grant program for Driving While Intoxicated (DWI) for the period of June 7, 2022 through June 21, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the grant consists of \$25,000.00 from TxDOT, which will fund overtime for San Antonio Police Department officers with the goal of reducing speed-related serious bodily injury and fatality collisions; and

WHEREAS, this grant does not require a cash match but requires an in-kind match of \$6,251.00 which will consist of indirect cost and motor vehicle maintenance; NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager and designee, and the San Antonio Chief of Police and designee, are hereby authorized to accept grant funds in an amount up to \$25,000.00 from TxDOT for the 2022 "Operation Slowdown" grant program for the grant period of June 7, 2022 through June 21, 2022. This ordinance also authorizes an in-kind match up to \$6,251.00 which will be fulfilled by SAPD indirect cost and motor vehicle maintenance. A copy of said application is on file with the San Antonio Police Department.

SECTION 2. The City Manager and designee, and the San Antonio Chief of Police and designee, are hereby authorized to execute any and all necessary documents to effectuate said application and acceptance.

SECTION 3. Upon acceptance of this award, a new fund and internal order number will be created, upon which the sum of up to \$25,000.00 from the TxDOT will be appropriated in said fund. The proposed budget, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Exhibit A**, is approved and adopted for entry in the City books.

SECTION 4. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Deputy Chief Financial Officer, City of San Antonio. The Deputy Chief Financial Officer may, subject

to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
