SECTION 1. The City Manager or designee, or the San Antonio Chief of Police or designee, is hereby authorized to apply and accept grant funds in an amount up to \$1,000,000.00 from the U.S. Department of Justice (DOJ), Office of Justice Programs (OJP), Bureau of Justice Assistance (BJA) for the FY 2022 Byrne Discretionary Community Project Funding. A copy of said application is on file with the San Antonio Police Department.

SECTION 2. The City Manager or designee, or the San Antonio Chief of Police or designee, is hereby authorized to execute any and all necessary documents to effectuate said application and acceptance.

SECTION 3. Upon acceptance of this award, a new fund and internal order number will be created, upon which the sum of up to \$1,000,000.00 from the DOJ will be appropriated in said fund. The proposed budget, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Exhibit II**, is approved and adopted for entry in the City books.

SECTION 4. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Deputy Chief Financial Officer, City of San Antonio. The Deputy Chief Financial Officer may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
