- \* \$1,758,468.41 Total Economic Value of Volunteers



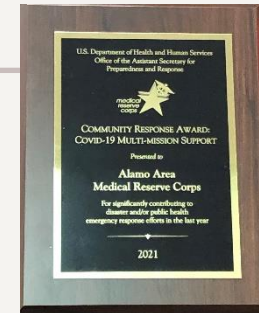


# Background

## MRC COVID-19 RISE Grant

### Awards Received:

- Proclamation from State Senator Jose Menendez for Volunteer efforts during critical disaster relief in times of great need
- Community Response Award: COVID-19 Multi-Mission Support from the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services





# Fiscal Impact

---

- Authorize the acceptance of funds from MRC COVID-19 RISE Grant in the amount of \$75,000.00 for a grant period of May 1, 2022- December 31, 2022.
