- Increase enforcement of traffic safety-related regulations
- Reduce fatal and serious injury crashes
- Increase occupant restraint usage in passenger vehicles and trucks
- Increase public education and information campaigns

Enforcement – 2021

May 24 – June 6, 2021

Type	Citations	Warnings
Seatbelt	46	122
Child Seat	10	1
Speeding	14	237
Distracted Driving	14	32
Arrests	28	

Grant Award

- **Grant Period: May 23, 2022 – June 5, 2022**
 - Grant funds - \$35,000
 - In-kind match - \$8,768
- **Grant will provide funding for overtime to promote vehicle restraint and child restraint use**
