Project Overview

 The Neighborhood and Housing Services Department solicited for qualified public or private nonprofit agencies, authorities, or organizations with the ability to determine program eligibility of homeowners and oversee housing rehabilitation services for these homeowners to be a subrecipient of the City's Minor Repair and/or Owner-Occupied Rehabilitation programs.

 Request for Proposal (RFP)

Estimated Value

 \$1 million annually; up to \$3 Million total

Proposed Term

• 1 year with 2, 1 year renewal options

Recommended Award

The evaluation committee met to review and discuss the responsive proposal on May 26, 2022, and, by consensus, recommends awarding a contract to the sole responsive bidder.
