**ORDINANCE**

**AUTHORIZING THE SAN ANTONIO OFFICE OF EMERGENCY  
MANAGEMENT TO APPLY FOR, ACCEPT, AND APPROPRIATE UPON  
AWARD UP TO \$5,097,720.00 FROM THE FEDERAL EMERGENCY  
MANAGEMENT AGENCY FROM THE HAZARD MITIGATION  
PROGRAM, AND AUTHORIZING AN IN-KIND MATCH OF \$509,729.09.**

**WHEREAS**, there are grant funds of as much as \$5,097,720.00 available from the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (HMGP) from the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA); and

**WHEREAS**, this grant, which is administered by the Texas Division of Emergency Management would be used to install permanent HVAC generators at 23 City facilities that are considered crucial during a disaster: six San Antonio Police Department Substations, fifteen community centers, and two senior centers; and

**WHEREAS**, this grant requires a ten percent cash or in-kind match estimated at \$509,772.09;  
**NOW THEREFORE:**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The City Manager and designee, and the Emergency Management Coordinator (EMC) and designee, are hereby authorized to submit a grant application and accept grant funding in an amount up to \$5,097,720.00 for the FEMA Hazard Mitigation Grant Program. A copy of said application is on file with the San Antonio Office of Emergency Management.

**SECTION 2.** The City Manager and designee, and the EMC and designee, are hereby authorized to accept said grant, if awarded under substantially the same terms and conditions as applied for, and to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate said application and acceptance, and any additional money awarded under this grant.

**SECTION 3.** Upon acceptance of this award, a new fund and internal order number will be created, upon which the sum of up to \$5,097,720.00 from FEMA will be appropriated in said fund. An in-kind or General Fund cash matching contribution of \$509,772.09 is hereby authorized. The proposed budget attached hereto as **Exhibit A** is hereby approved. A formal budget will be provided upon acceptance of funds.

**SECTION 4.** The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Deputy Chief Financial Officer, City of San Antonio. The Deputy Chief Financial Officer may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific

SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 5.** This ordinance is effective immediately upon passage by eight affirmative votes; otherwise it is effective on the tenth day after passage.
