Project Background

- Patrol North is located in Council District 9
- Unleaded fueling facility on site
- FY 2022 FY 2027
 Capital Improvement Program Project
- Underground fuel storage tanks (USTs)
 have reached the end of their
 operational lifecycle





Project Scope

- Remove existing and install new:
 - □ USTs
 - Piping
 - Dispensers
 - Automatic Tank Gauge System
- Maintain integrity of fueling systems in accordance with Texas Commission on Environmental Quality
- Project Construction Cost: \$817,112.50

Procurement of Services (cont.)

- Bids opened May 17, 2022
 - 3 bidders responded
 - Lowest bidder deemed non-responsive due to not meeting Bid Bond requirements
 - D&H United Fueling Solutions, Inc. submitted the lowest responsive bid
 - ✓ Licensed by TCEQ to remove and install USTs
 - SBEDA Ordinance requirements were waived due to the lack of small, minority, and/or women businesses
