AmeriCorps has partnered with the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) to create Public Health AmeriCorps through CDC's American Rescue Plan Act funds.

Public Health AmeriCorps programs will support health equity, mental health and substance use disorders, COVID-19 recovery, and will increase access to services, especially in underserved communities.





## **Air Quality Outreach Promoter**

• The AmeriCorps member will work with local organizations to educate the public on air quality and activities they can take to reduce ozone and improve air quality.

## Metro Health Asthma Outreach

 The AmeriCorps member will assist with outreach and recruitment as well as training for the San Antonio Kids BREATHE (SAKB) program





- Authorize the acceptance of funds in the amount of \$57,600.00 annually for a total amount up to \$172,800.00 with renewals
- Grant Period: September 1, 2022 through August 30, 2023
  - Renewals: Two, one-year renewal periods through August 30, 2025
- There is a fiscal impact on the General Fund in the form of a cash match of up to \$53,528.00 annually for a total amount up to \$160,584.00





 Staff recommends City Council authorize the acceptance of funds from the AmeriCorps State and National Public Health Grant in the amount of \$57,600.00.
