## NACCHO IPACE

Opportunity offered by the National Association of County and City Health Officials (NACCHO) in collaboration with Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC)

Funding departments with academic detailing programs to pilot projects focused on pediatric settings

Will provide education through one-on-one discussions with providers on the impact of adverse childhood experiences (ACEs) and Positive Childhood Experiences (PCEs)



Addresses 3 of the 6 SA Forward Plan priority areas

- Violence Prevention
- Access to Care
- Mental Health and Community Resilience (MHCR)

Address trauma on a universal level – with an understanding that ACEs are common

- Triple P program
- Trauma informed care (TIC) in the justice system
- Establishing a city-wide Center for Excellence in TIC

Clinician Ambassadors develop relationships with medical providers

- One on one visits with providers
- Continuing Education opportunities
- Encouraging evidence-based practices



- Authorize the acceptance of funds for the NACCHO-IPACE Project in the amount of \$80,000.00
- Grant Period: May 10, 2022, through February 28, 2023
- There is no fiscal impact to the General Fund.
