- Metro Health has contracted with the University of Texas Health Science Center at Tyler (UTHSCT) for TB related physician services for 7+ years
- UTHSCT is one of four Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) TB Centers of Excellence (TB COEs) for training, education, and medical consultation in the United States



- In 2017, City Council first authorized participation in the Tuberculosis Identification and Treatment Project (TB Project) under the Texas Medicaid 1115 Waiver, through a sub-award from DSHS
- Project increases testing for latent tuberculosis infection (LTBI) in high-risk populations to prevent active cases
- UTHSCT physicians treat patients with LTBI





- Initial Term: October 1, 2021 through July 31, 2022
 - Initial Amount: \$99,739.00
- Renewal and Amendment Term: August 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023
 - Amount: \$109,712.00
- Funding for this agreement is available and budgeted through the TB Medicaid Waiver Fund
- No impact to General Fund
