Apprenticeship Building America Grant

- \$2,983,433 Grant
- Department of Labor
- 4-year term ending June 2026
- Goal:
 - Expand apprenticeship & pre-apprenticeship opportunities with RTW-pledged employers

Deliverables:

- Pre-Apprenticeship Programs
 - Enroll 680 Participants
- Registered Apprenticeship Programs
 - Enroll 425 Participants

Target industries:

- Healthcare/Bioscience
- Manufacturing
- Skilled Trades
- Education
- Transportation
- IT/Cybersecurity
- Public Sector

Target populations:

- Ready to Work participants
- Persons with prior justice-system involvement
- Victims of domestic violence



Major Program Elements and Budget

Administration - \$1.6M

- Coordinate with industry councils and employers to develop pre-apprenticeship and apprenticeship pathways
- Coordinate with communitybased organizations and educational institutions to provide awareness

Partnerships - \$1.1M

Subcontracts for:

- Curriculum developed for employers by educators and training providers
- Evaluation and Impact Study
- Employer and Participant Engagement

Stipends - \$270k

Participant support to encourage persistence and completion
