**AN ORDINANCE**

**AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE GRANT FUNDS IN  
AN AMOUNT UP TO \$815,785.00 FROM THE MOTOR  
VEHICLE CRIME PREVENTION AUTHORITY FOR THE  
REGIONAL AUTO CRIMES TEAM PROJECT FOR THE  
GRANT PERIOD BEGINNING SEPTEMBER 1, 2022 TO  
AUGUST 21, 2023, WITH A CASH MATCH FROM THE  
CITY OF \$466,679.00 AND AN IN-KIND MATCH OF  
\$2,256,211.00.**

**WHEREAS**, the Motor Vehicle Crime Prevention Authority (MVCPA) has grant funds available to fund the Regional Auto Crimes Team (ReACT), in an amount up to \$815,785.00; and

**WHEREAS**, the grant would be used to provide funding for eleven positions, nine with the San Antonio Police Department and two with the Texas Department of Public Safety (DPS), to reduce automobile burglary and theft offenses; and

**WHEREAS**, the grant is for the period from September 1, 2022, to August 31, 2023; and

**WHEREAS**, a cash match is required, with the City of San Antonio contributing \$466,679.00 and the National Insurance Crime Bureau (NICB) contributing \$90,202.00; an in-kind contribution is required, with the City contributing \$2,256,211.00 and DPS contributing \$130,985.00; **NOW THEREFORE:**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The City Manager and designee, and the Chief of Police and designee, are hereby authorized to accept grant funds in an amount up to \$815,785.00.00 from MVCPA, which requires a cash match of \$466,679.00 from the city and the NICB contributing \$90,202.00 as salary in lieu of cash match, and an in-kind match of \$2,256,211.00 from the City and \$130,985.00 from DPS, for the ReACT Project for the grant period September 1, 2022 through August 31, 2023. A copy of said application is on file with the San Antonio Police Department. The City Manager and designee, and the Chief of Police and designee, are further authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate said acceptance.

**SECTION 2.** New funds and internal order numbers will be created, upon which the award amount of \$815,785.00.00 from MVCPA will be appropriated in said fund. A formal final budget which will include a department specific fund, an Internal Order number, and General Ledger numbers will be submitted by the department upon award. The proposed budget, attached hereto as **Attachment A**, is hereby approved and adopted for entry in the City books.

**SECTION 3.** City cash match not to exceed \$466,679.00 is contingent upon the approval of the fiscal year 2022 General Fund Budget.

**SECTION 4.** The attached proposed personnel complement of eleven positions, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Attachment B**, is approved.

**SECTION 5.** The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance, may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 6.** This Ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
