- Street Maintenance Program (SMP) is a component of the 5-Year Infrastructure Management Program (IMP).
- The FY 2022 Budget approved \$110 Million for the SMP to complete pavement preservation and rehabilitation projects.
- The FY 2023 SMP Budget is anticipated to include \$130 Million for the completion of pavement preservation and rehabilitation projects.
- This contract will facilitate the completion of pavement preservation projects.
