PROJECT BACKGROUND

Background:

800 Miles Total Underground Storm Water Pipes

303 Miles Underground Pipe Televised To Date

60 Miles Cleaned and Televised Annually

45 Miles Corrugated Metal Pipe (CMP) Under Streets

7 Miles CMP Televised Requiring Repair

PROJECT SCOPE

- Four methods of trenchless rehabilitation
 - Cured-In-Place-Pipe
 - Invert Paving
 - Sliplining
 - Spray-On Lining
- 8,000 Linear Feet (LF) of CMP will be rehabilitated
- Individual locations will be prioritized in order of most need
- Criteria based on the condition of existing pipe and classification of roadway
