Goals

Program enhances the Department's efforts to combat vehicle crimes

- Institute innovative enforcement and theft prevention techniques
- Lower number of vehicles stolen
- Increase vehicle recovery rates

Program Results - 2021

Arrests – 373

Warrants Cleared – 177


Search Warrants – 29

Recovered Vehicles – 816

Recovered Value - \$12.41 million

Grant Award

- Grant allows SAPD to enhance efforts to combat vehicle crimes
- Grant Period September 1, 2022 to August 31, 2023
- Grant: \$815,785 and partially funds 7 detectives and 2 civilians
- City Match:
 - In-Kind Match \$2,256,211
 - Cash Match \$466,679

City Council acceptance of grant funds not to exceed \$815,785 from the Motor Vehicle Crime Prevention Authority to support vehicle theft prevention initiatives
