Project & Solicitation Overview

Project Scope/Overview: CCDO is seeking proposals from qualified firms to provide dockless vehicle transportation options for residents. The solicitation is expected to award contracts to two firms that will each be permitted to operate 1,000 dockless vehicles on City right-of-way.
