BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. Gwendolyn Bolden (District 2) is appointed to the Affirmative Action Advisory Committee for the remainder of the unexpired term of office to expire May 31, 2023.

SECTION 2. The residency requirement of City Code, Chapter 2, Section 2-529(b), Article IX, is waived for this appointment.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes, otherwise, it is effective ten days after appointment.


