Background

Dental Caries Prevalence



*Tooth decay is the most common chronic disease of childhood, affecting **3X's** more children than obesity and **4X's** more than asthma. (1)*



*1 in 5 children has had **tooth decay by kindergarten** and more than half have had cavities by age eight. (2)*



***Cavities** make children more **vulnerable to infections** in other parts of their body, such as *ears, sinuses, and brain*. (3)*



*Pain from tooth decay can keep a child from **eating properly**, getting adequate nutrition, **hindering** many children from **going to school** or paying attention in class. (4)*

Background

- Dr. Davenport has served as Metro Health's Clinical Dental Director from 2020 to present
- Previously provided clinician services from 2013 to 2019
- Required by the State of Texas, Dr. Davenport provides:
 - Oversight to the program's clinical operations
 - High quality dental care to uninsured or underinsured children
- Oral Health program identified the need to increase the number of hours worked by Dr. Davenport.



Fiscal Impact

- Initial Term: October 1, 2020 through September 30, 2021
 - Initial Amount: \$61,000.00
- Renewal Term: October 1, 2021 through September 30, 2022
 - Renewal Amount: \$61,000.00
- Renewal and Amendment Term: October 1, 2022 through September 30, 2023
 - Amount: \$77,000.00, funded through two sources:
 - 1115 Medicaid Waiver: \$61,000.00
 - General Fund: \$16,000.00
- Total contract value: \$199,000.00



Recommendation

- Staff recommends City Council approve an amendment to an agreement with Rebecca Davenport, DDS.
