- 340B Prescription Drug Pricing Program
 - Federal program
 - Enables participating drug manufacturers to provide discounted prices on prescription drugs to participating health care organizations
 - Allows for participating organizations to stretch resources
- Health care organizations may contract with pharmacies to dispense drugs purchased through wholesale distributors as part of the program





 Agreements for a contract pharmacy and a prescription drug wholesale distributor were solicited through Request for Proposals (RFP)

Walgreen Co.

- Contract Pharmacy
- Reimbursed Amount up to \$250,000
- Term: October 1, 2022-September 30, 2023
- Options to renew for two,
 1-year terms

Cardinal Health

- Wholesale Drug Distributor
- Expenses up to \$250,000
- Term: October 1, 2022-September 30, 2023
- Options to renew for two,1-year terms



Staff recommends approval of agreements with Walgreen Co. to serve as the Contract Pharmacy and Cardinal Health to serve as the contract wholesale drug distributor for Metro Health's participation in the 340B Prescription Drug Pricing Program for patients seen at Metro Health clinics
