- Street Maintenance Program (SMP) is a component of the 5-Year Infrastructure Management Program (IMP).
- The FY 2023 SMP Budget is anticipated to include \$120 Million for the completion of pavement preservation and rehabilitation projects. An additional \$10 Million has been awarded from the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (ARPA) for a total SMP Budget of \$130 Million.
- This contract will facilitate the completion of pavement preservation projects.
