

RFCA #22-186722

SECTION 1. The City Manager or designee, or the Deputy Chief Financial Officer or designee, authorizes a contract with FarrWest Environmental Supply, Inc. to provide the San Antonio Fire Department Hazmat Hazardous Materials Response Team with two FLIR Griffin G510 Field Ready Kits for a total cost of \$282,530.00. Funding is from the 2020 Homeland Security Grant Program, U.S. Department of Homeland Security Federal Management Agency.

SECTION 2. Current funding is available in Internal Order 120000000205, GL 5709080, Fund 2205620025 entitled “2020 Homeland Security Grant” for a total amount of \$282,530.00.

SECTION 3. Payment not to exceed \$282,530.00 is authorized to FarrWest Environmental Supply, Inc. to provide the San Antonio Fire Department (SAFD) Hazmat Hazardous Materials Response Team with two FLIR Griffin G510 Field Ready Kits upon issuance of a purchase order.

SECTION 4. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Deputy Chief Financial Officer, City of San Antonio. The Deputy Chief Financial Officer may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
