3. Update on the TAB proposed amendments to Chapter 33 and TAB Chairperson:

- Group Cycles and the concern that there is no limit on the number of permits
- What are the average hours worked and wages for taxicab drivers in San Antonio?

The committee did not move the amendments forward to the full City Council, and we would be taken the items back to the Transportation and Mobility Committee on September 20, 2022.

A discussion was held on taxicab rates, and Mr. Gilbert presented the TAB with new Staff recommended rates to be closer to other Texas Cities.

Mr. Rodriguez made a motion to reject the Staff rate recommendation and move forward with the industry proposed rates; R. Gonzalez second the motion.
