


## Taxiway H Reconstruction Phase 1



# Taxiway H Reconstruction Phase 1

- Full-depth reconstruction of a section of existing Taxiway/Taxilane H pavement to include relocation of a portion of Taxilane H between apron and Taxiway A.
- Drainage and airfield electrical improvements will be installed and a FAA duct bank, impacted by the construction, will be relocated and upgraded to fiber communications.
- Shift Taxilane CL to the north along the limits of the Remain Over Night (RON) ramp and remove direct apron from the runway providing safer maneuvering for aircraft.

#### **Invitation To Bid**

- Released May 2, 2022
- 3 Bids opened on June 3, 2022
- Flatiron Construction submitted lowest, responsive bid in the amount of \$12,705,802.30
- Solicitated under the FAA's Disadvantaged Business Enterprise Program with a goal of 11%, which the firm committed to exceed
