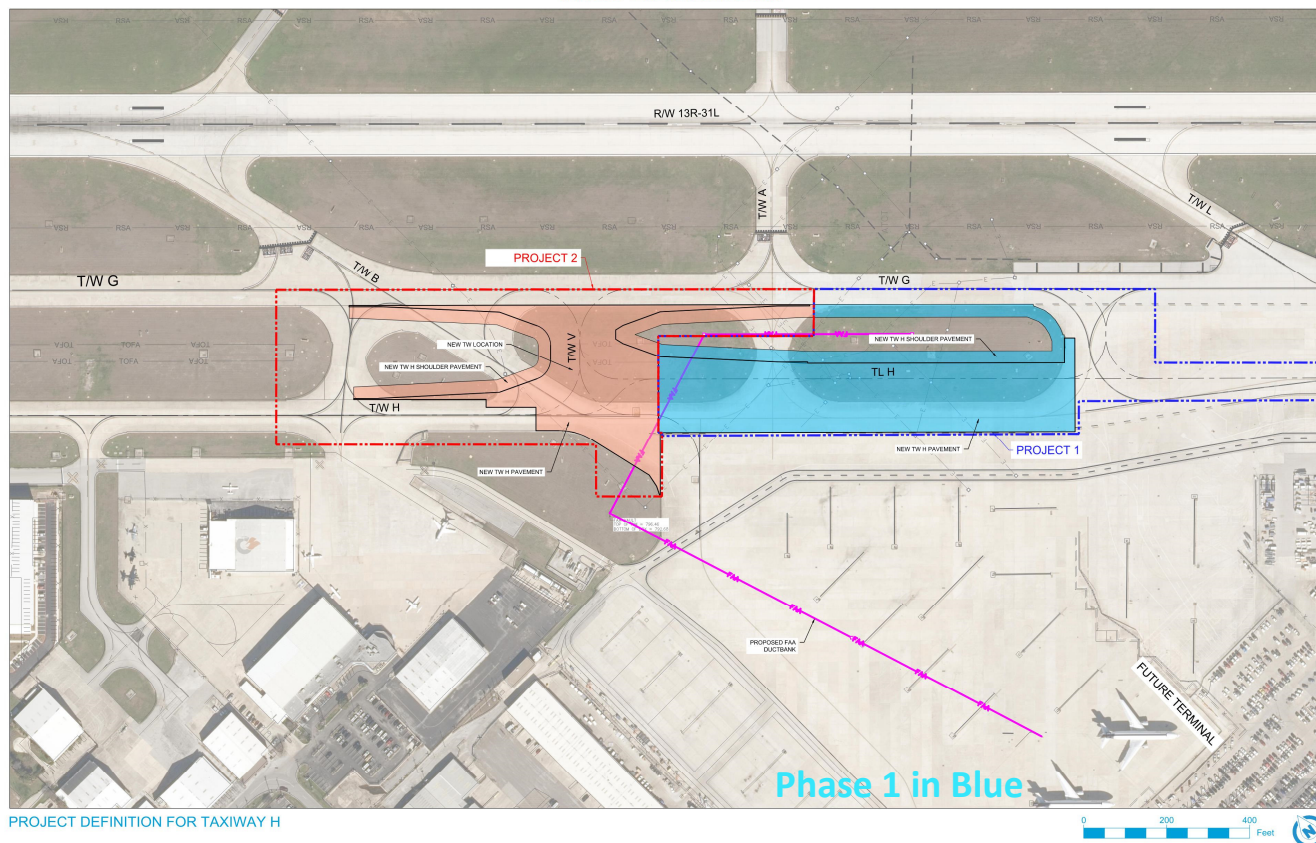

Taxiway H Reconstruction Phase 1

- Full-depth reconstruction of a section of existing Taxiway/Taxilane H pavement to include relocation of a portion of Taxilane H between apron and Taxiway A.
- Drainage and airfield electrical improvements will be installed and a FAA duct bank, impacted by the construction, will be relocated and upgraded to fiber communications.
- Shift Taxilane CL to the north along the limits of the Remain Over Night (RON) ramp and remove direct apron from the runway providing safer maneuvering for aircraft.
