

Grant Overview

•UASI Grant Program was created in 2003 in response to 9/11 terrorist attack

•Funding to Protect Communities Against Terrorist Attacks

•San Antonio Urban Area conditionally awarded \$3.8 Million (Regional Grant)

- Cyber-Security
- Emergency Management and EOC
- Management and Administration
- Bexar County and Other Jurisdictions (\$1.2 Million)
- Texas Management and Administration Cost (\$190,000)
