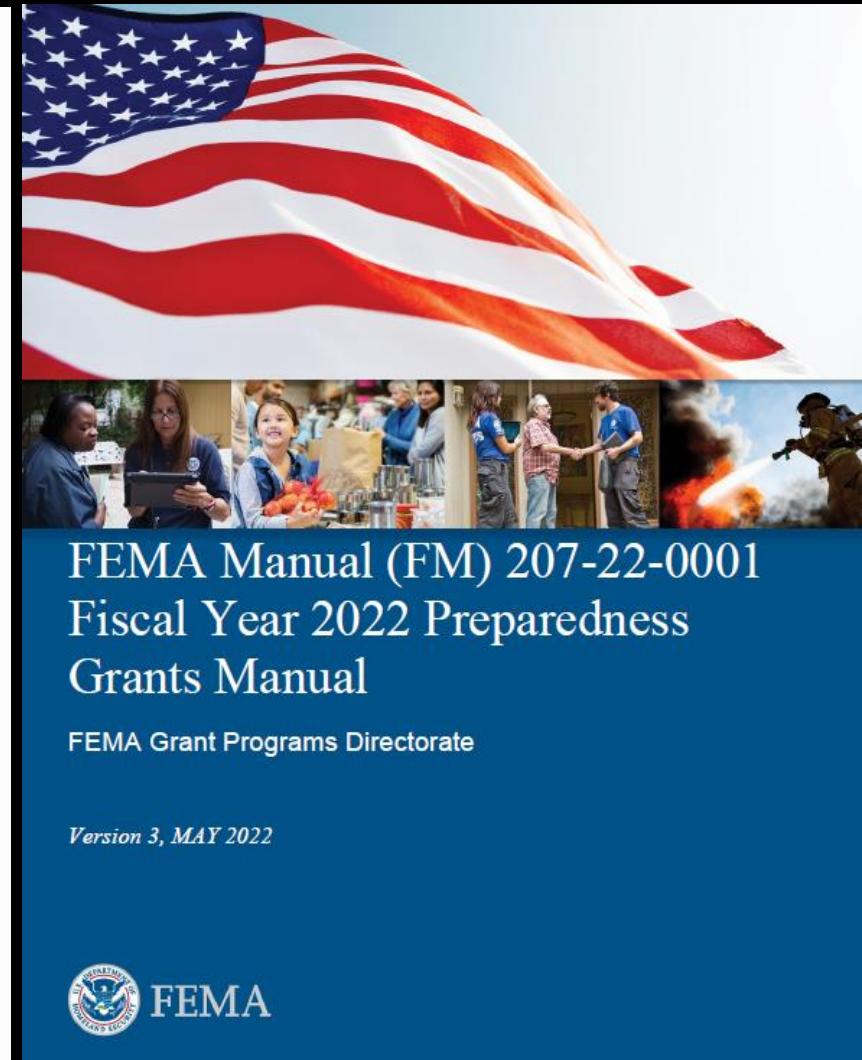

Grant Overview

- Texas Awarded \$18,210,451
- AACOG Awarded \$1,324,044
- AACOG's Regional Emergency Preparedness Advisory Committee (REPAC) Competitively Awards Projects Based on Risk Scoring
- City of San Antonio Awarded \$877,229 (66%)



2022 State Homeland Security Program AACOG Award \$1,324,043

- **San Antonio Awarded \$877,229**
 - **SAPD Protection of Crowded Places & Soft Targets (\$464,600)**
 - **SAFD Protection of Crowded Places & Soft Targets (\$205,629)**
 - **Southwest Texas Regional Fusion Center (\$207,000)**
- **AACOG Awarded (\$240,000)**
- **Bexar County and Other Jurisdictions (\$206,814)**
