City of San Antonio Investment Policy

- Incorporates Mandates Required by the Texas Public Funds Investment Act
- Sets Investment Guidelines
- Provides a List of Authorized Investments
- Establishes the City's Investment Committee

City of San Antonio Investment Policy

The investment objectives, as stated in the City's Investment Policy are:

- To satisfy cash flow requirements
- To ensure the preservation and safety of principal
- To provide for liquidity and diversification
- To maximize yield on investments
- To engage in proactive portfolio management

United States Treasuries

- Treasury Bills "T-Bills"
 - Maturities of 1 year or less
 - Trade at a discount to par
 - Mature at par
- Treasury Notes "T-Notes"
 - Maturities between 1-10 years
 - Pay interest on a semi-annual basis
- Treasury STRIPS "T-Strip"
 - Maturities of 30 years and less
 - Trade at a discount to par
 - Mature at par

- Government Sponsored Agencies
 - Federal National Mortgage Association "Fannie Mae" (FNMA)
 - Federal Home Loan Mortgage Corporation "Freddie Mac" (FHLMC)
 - Federal Home Loan Banks (FHLB)
 - Federal Farm Credit Bank (FFCB)
 - Federal Agricultural Mortgage Corporation "Farmer Mac" (FAMC)

Repurchase Agreement

- A repurchase agreement (or "Repo") agreement where one party sells the other a security at a specified price with a commitment to buy the security back at a later date for another specified price.
- Typically overnight transactions

Money Market Mutual Fund

 The City currently utilizes Fidelity Investments Money Market Mutual Funds as a cash management tool

Government Investment Pools

 The City currently utilizes Tex-Pool Government Investment Pools as a cash management tool

Investment Committee

- Meets at least quarterly to receive a report on the most recent quarter's investment activity, cash position of the City, and proposed investment activity for the next quarter
- Reviews and suggests any changes or adjustments to the City's investment practices
- Annually approves list of Broker/Dealers

- Two Representatives from the City Council
- Three Representatives from the City Manager's Office
- Deputy Chief Financial Officer
- Director of the Office of Management and Budget
- Assistant Director of Finance Financial Services
- Division of Financial Management
 - Financial Management Administrator
 - Financial Manager
 - Banking Officer
 - Investment Officers

2023 Investment Policy Updates

- Minor changes made throughout the Investment Policy to update various terms
- No significant or material changes made to the Investment Policy

Pooled Investment Approach

- Investments are pooled into two primary categories
 - Operating funds
 - Debt Service funds
- Pooled operating funds consist of balances from the City's various funds invested in an aggregate or pooled portfolio structure, with principal and interest income distributed to each respective fund on a pro rata basis
