About Workforce Solutions Alamo


- ► Governing Board for the regional workforce system
- Represents taxpayers of the 13-county Alamo region
 - Atascosa, Bandera, Bexar, Comal, Frio, Gillespie, Guadalupe, Karnes, Kendall, Kerr, McMullen, Medina and Wilson
- 25 Board members
 - Oversee implementation of state and federal workforce programs
 - Reflect business, economic development, education, labor, community organizations, and government
- Elected officials from WSA service area are parties to an Interlocal and Partnership Agreement
 - Agreements create "Committee of Six" which performs the duties of elected officials
 - Agreements require City Council approval of annual operating budget

Prior year Performance Metrics

- Over 115,000 total clients served
- Over 29,000 job postings
- 4,919 program participants (26k units of service)
- 7,432 placed in a job
- Over 9,000 children provided daily childcare
