a. Salaries and Wages Decrease \$ (637,245)

Our program has experienced an average of 12 vacancies per month since the beginning of this budget period. These vacancies are primarily in our family support staff, which make up about 10 vacancies on average. In an effort to attract and retain talent the City of San Antonio has increased the base salary for family support staff effective Oct 1.

This equipment and vehicle is and will be stored at 1227 Brady Blvd. DHS Head Start will also purchase two (2) Viewsonic VIewBoard for the Explorer Conference room located at 1227 Brady Blvd. The cost per unit is \$5,290 each.

DHS Head Start will repave and restripe the entire parking lot located at 1227 Brady Blvd. The parking lot is the original parking surface for over 20 years. Currently, the parking lot has many potholes and uneven areas making this unsafe for families and staff to use. Also, in taking steps to make the building at 1227 Brady Blvd energy efficient, DHS Head Start will install electrical light sensors as well as update light switches and electrical work throughout the building. DHS Head Start will also replace four to six urinals in the restrooms at 1227 Brady Blvd.
