Brief Description of Item(s) and Use: This contract will provide the Building and Equipment Services and Solid Waste Management departments with Diesel Exhaust Fluid (DEF) in bulk, 55 gallon and 2.5-gallon containers. Diesel Exhaust Fluid is a solution of urea and water that's injected into the exhaust stream of diesel vehicles to turn NOx gases (harmful emissions) into nitrogen and water. This system is called a Selective Catalytic Reduction (SCR) implemented by vehicle manufacturers to meet EPA emissions standards.
