## **ORDINANCE**

APPROVING THE FOLLOWING CONTRACTS ESTABLISHING UNIT PRICES FOR GOODS AND SERVICES FOR AN ESTIMATED ANNUAL \$510,000.00, **INCLUDED COST OF** IN THE RESPECTIVE DEPARTMENT'S FY 2023 ADOPTED BUDGET: (A) GONZALEZ AUTO PARTS LTD., FOR AUTOMOBILE AND LIGHT-DUTY TRUCK DRUM AND BRAKE REPLACEMENT PARTS FOR REPAIRS; (B) ZAMORANO ENTERPRISES, INC., FOR DECORATIVE DUAL TRASH AND RECYCLE METAL RECEPTACLES; AND (C) DIGITAL SANDBOX, INC., FOR MAINTENANCE AND SUPPORT FOR THE CONSTELLATION AND SECURITY PLATFORM.

WHEREAS, the City is able to obtain significant savings by purchasing various materials and services on an annual contract basis; and

WHEREAS, the bids submitted by Cavender Grande Ford and O'Reilly Auto Enterprises, LLC, failed to meet the City's specifications and/or requirements for automobile and light light-duty truck drum and brake replacement parts for repairs; and

WHEREAS, the Texas Local Government Code indicates that competitive bidding is not required under section 252.022(a)(7)(A), which provides for any items that are available only from a sole source of supply; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance approves one low responsive bid contract, one low bid contract, and one contract on the basis of sole source with (A) Gonzalez Auto Parts Ltd., for automobile and light-duty truck drum and brake replacement parts for repairs; (B) Zamorano Enterprises, Inc., for decorative dual trash and recycle metal receptacles; and (C) Digital Sandbox, Inc., for maintenance and support for the Constellation for Safety and Security platform, respectively; and

WHEREAS, all expenditures will be in accordance with the applicable fiscal year's budget approved by City Council; NOW THEREFORE:

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

**SECTION 1.** The following bids and offers to furnish the City with goods and services on an annual basis as shown on the attached bid tabulation sheets are hereby accepted, subject to and contingent upon the deposit of all required bonds, performance deposits, insurance certificates and endorsements: (A) Gonzalez Auto Parts Ltd., for automobile and light-duty truck drum and brake replacement parts for repairs; (B) Zamorano Enterprises, Inc., for decorative dual trash and recycle metal receptacles; and (C) Digital Sandbox, Inc., for maintenance and support for the Constellation for Safety and Security platform.
