## **ORDINANCE**

ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS FROM THE SOUTHWEST TEXAS REGIONAL ADVISORY COUNCIL FOR TRAUMA IN AN AMOUNT UP TO \$396,313.00 FOR THE SAN ANTONIO FIRE DEPARTMENT, EMS DIVISION, MOBILE INTEGRATED HEALTHCARE UNIT, FOR THE OPIOD PREVENTION CRISIS RESPONSE PROGRAM.

**WHEREAS**, the Southwest Texas Regional Advisory Council for Trauma (STRAC) was established to facilitate the development, implementation, and operation of a regional comprehensive trauma and emergency healthcare system; and

**WHEREAS**, STRAC has funds in an amount up to \$396,313.00 for the San Antonio Fire Department (SAFD), Emergency Medical Services (EMS) Division, Mobile Integrated Healthcare (MIH) Unit; and

**WHEREAS**, the funds would be used for the period of October 1, 2022 to September 30, 2023 to help improve the outcome of residents that have suffered narcotics overdoses; **NOW THEREFORE**:

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

**SECTION 1.** The City Manager and designee, and the Chief of SAFD and designee, are hereby authorized to accept funds an amount up to \$396,313.00 from the STRAC that will be used by the SAFD EMS Division, MIH Unit, for education, training and rehabilitation support for individuals at high risk of narcotic overdose, and their families, and are further authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate said acceptance.

**SECTION 2.** Upon acceptance of this award, a new fund and internal order number will be created, upon which the sum not to exceed \$396,313.00 will be appropriated. A final and formal budget, which will include Internal Order numbers and General Ledger numbers, will be submitted by the department upon award.

**SECTION 3.** The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 4.** This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage, provided that it is passed by eight or more affirmative votes; otherwise, this ordinance shall take effect ten days from the date of passage.
