## AN ORDINANCE

PROVIDING FOR THE EXTENSION OF THE CITY LIMITS OF SAN ANTONIO BY THE FULL PURPOSE ANNEXATION, AS REQUESTED BY MARK AND ROBIN VERSTUYFT, THE LANDOWNERS OF APPROXIMATELY 50.131 ACRES OF CB 4298, GENERALLY LOCATED SOUTHEAST OF THE INTERSECTION OF WATSON ROAD AND VERANO PARKWAY, CONTIGUOUS TO THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO'S LIMITS AND LOCATED WITHIN THE SAN ANTONIO EXTRATERRITORIAL JURISDICTION (ETJ), IN BEXAR COUNTY, APPROVING A SERVICE AGREEMENT FOR THE TERRITORY.

**WHEREAS**, Chapter 43 of the Texas Local Government Code and the City Charter of San Antonio provide that a City may conduct annexation for full purposes of territory upon the request of the landowner; and

WHEREAS, Mark and Robin Verstuyft (Owners) are the landowners of approximately 50.131 acres of CB 4298, constituting one tract of land, generally located southeast of the intersection of Watson Road and Verano Parkway, in the San Antonio ETJ and contiguous to the city limits of San Antonio; and

WHEREAS, on October 9, 2022, proper notice of the public hearing was published in the San Antonio Express-News, being a newspaper of general circulation in the municipality and in the territory proposed for annexation and posted on the internet website maintained by the City of San Antonio in accordance with Chapter 43 of the Texas Local Government Code; and

WHEREAS, on November 10, 2022, the San Antonio City Council held a public hearing on the proposed annexation of the 50.131 acres of land, generally located southeast of the intersection of Watson Road and Verano Parkway, and the public hearing gave all interested persons the right to appear and be heard on the proposed annexation; and

WHEREAS, the population of the City of San Antonio, Texas, is in excess of 1,451,853 inhabitants, and the territory to be annexed lies within the ETJ of the City of San Antonio, Texas, and lies adjacent to and adjoining the City of San Antonio, Texas; NOW THEREFORE,

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

**SECTION 1.** The petition (**Attachment "A"**) requesting the annexation of the 50.131-acre territory, legally described as 50.131 acres out of CB 4298, that was submitted by the landowners is hereby granted. The territory is more particularly depicted in **EXHIBIT "A"** and described in **EXHIBIT "B"** both contained in **Attachment "A"** attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes.

**SECTION 2.** The unincorporated territory lying outside of, but adjacent to and adjoining the City of San Antonio, more particularly described and depicted in **EXHIBITS "A"** and **"B,"** is hereby added and annexed to the City of San Antonio, Texas, and said territory shall hereafter be included within the municipal boundary of San Antonio, and the present corporate limits of San Antonio, at the various points contiguous to the territory described and depicted in **EXHIBITS "A"** and **"B,"** are altered and amended so as to include said newly annexed territory within the corporate limits of the City of San Antonio, Texas.

**SECTION 3.** The newly annexed territory so added shall bear its share of the taxes levied by the City of San Antonio, Texas. The owners and inhabitants thereof shall be entitled to all of the rights and the privileges as citizens and shall be bound by the acts, ordinances, resolutions, and regulations of the City of San Antonio, Texas.

**SECTION 4.** A Service Agreement outlining the provisions of municipal service to the territory described and depicted in **EXHIBITS "A"** and "B," and is hereby approved and the implementation of said Agreement is hereby authorized. Such Agreement is attached hereto and executed herein as if set out verbatim for all purposes as **EXHIBIT "C."** 

**SECTION 5.** In accordance with Section 35-307(a) of the City of San Antonio Unified Development Code, this property shall be zoned by separate ordinance and the assigned zoning district will be effective upon annexation.

**SECTION 6**. The land and territory annexed by this ordinance shall be represented by and be a part of City Council District 4.

**SECTION 7**. The statements set forth in the recitals of this ordinance are true and correct and are incorporated as a part of this ordinance.

**SECTION 8.** This ordinance shall be effective on November 30, 2022.
