Contract Overview

- Term: 3 years, with 2 one-year renewals
- •\$1 year rent
- •250 Free Surgeries for residents
- 6,500 low-cost surgeries for San Antonio Residents
- •Up to \$30,000 annual incentives at year two
- ACS will fund \$70,000 of equipment replacements and start-up costs
- Inspections:
 - Advisory Board Quarterly Inspections
 - Staff Inspections anytime

Operations Overview

- Will operate Tuesday Friday (hours and days subject to ACS Director approval)
- Vet already hired, hiring staffing now
- Call center and centralized booking for all clinics in one location
- Bi-lingual Call Center
- Opportunity for transportation to surgery
- First Board Inspection will be January 2023 (D6)
