Monitoring Report – October 2022

The Early Head Start (EHS) Program has developed a comprehensive and thorough approach to monitoring for non-compliances and areas of concern. Once identified, a timeline is developed, training and technical assistance is given, and corrective action plans are implemented to correct systemic issues, so areas of weakness are not continued in the future. Follow-up monitoring events are conducted to ensure that the program has been successful in implementing corrections.

Non-Compliances – There were no non-compliances observed that showed a systemic or substantial material issue or concern in meeting performance standards or policy relating to the education services.

Follow-up Activities:

EHS Child Care Director's provided corrective action responses and evidence supporting the actions taken in the ChildPlus Data System. Follow up verification completed, and monitoring projects are now closed.

Monitors will follow up on CAP responses for Transportation File review and 45 Day Sensory Child File Review.
