SUBJECT:

Consideration of applicants and selection of up to three candidates to interview to temporarily fill the City Council District 10 office.

SUMMARY:

On November 14, 2022, the Councilmember Clayton Perry announced a temporary leave of absence from the City Council of the City of San Antonio. On November 14, 2022, the City Council initiated the process to select a temporary councilmember to fill the vacancy on for the City Council District 10.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

On November 14, 2022, Councilmember Clayton Perry announced a temporary leave of absence from the City Council of the City of San Antonio.

On November 14, 2022, the City Council initiated the process as provided by Section 2-36 of the City Code to select a temporary councilmember for the City Council District 10 office. The appointee will hold office until Councilmember Perry's return to office.

The Office of the City Clerk will accept applications for the temporary vacancy from November 14, 2022 through 5:00 p.m. on November 28, 2022.

On November 30, 2022, the City Council will consider the applications received by the City Clerk and select up to three candidates to interview to temporarily fill the City Council District 10 office.

On December 1, 2022, the Mayor and City Council may interview the selected candidates and select a temporary councilmember for the City Council District 10 office. If there are eight or more votes in favor of an appointment, then the individual will be immediately sworn-in and take a seat on the dais. If there are seven or six votes in favor then the individual will be sworn-in on December 12, 2022 and participate in the December 14, 2022 City Council B Session.

ISSUE:

The District 10 vacancy is being filled in accordance with the provisions outlined in Section 8 of the City Charter and Section 2-36 of the City Code which states that the Mayor and Council may appoint a person to serve as a Councilmember on a temporary basis.

The City Clerk recommends City Council select up to three candidates to interview on Thursday, December 1, 2022 at 9:00 am to temporarily fill the City Council District 10 office.
