**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**





### GENERAL FUND Finance

**SECTION 1.** Portions of the following City Code sections are hereby amended to read as indicated below. Additions are underlined, and deletions are struck through. Portions not reproduced below are not changed by this Ordinance.

**SECTION 2.** **Conduit Issuance Due Diligence Fee.** The conduit issuance due diligence fee to be charged by and payable to the Finance Department in connection with City Council consideration and approval of each conduit issuance transaction is hereby revised as follows:

- (a) For a conduit issuance issued by a Public Facilities Corporation, Educational Facilities Corporation, or similar entity created by the City of San Antonio, the due diligence fee shall be \$2,500 per transaction.
- (b) For a conduit issuance issued by an issuer not created by the City of San Antonio, the due diligence fee shall be 0.1% with no maximum fee and a base fee of \$10,000.

**SECTION 3. Full force and effect.** All other provisions of the City Code shall remain in full force and effect, unless expressly amended by this Attachment or other provisions of this Ordinance.

## ATTACHMENT D

### GENERAL FUND Fire

**SECTION 1.** Portions of the following City Code sections are hereby amended to read as indicated below. Additions are underlined, and deletions are ~~struck through~~. Portions not reproduced below are not changed by this Ordinance.

**SECTION 2.** Section 16-3(c) of the City Code is amended to change the fee for retail sales of fuel by service stations:

(c) The annual permit fees listed in table I shall be applied based upon the maximum quantity of a hazardous material present at any one time during the preceding year, except that each service station engaged in retail sales of fuel shall pay a flat fee of six hundred dollars (\$600.00) per location. Exception: Retail service stations storing ~~twenty-four thousand~~ (24,000) thirty thousand (30,000) gallons of fuel or less shall pay a flat fee of ~~\$300.00~~ \$150.00 per location.

**SECTION 3.** Section 16-3 of the City Code, Table I, Hazardous Materials Fees, Section 001, is amended to read as follows:

**SECTION 4.** Projector Rental fee: \$750.00 per projector per day

**SECTION 5.** Orchestra Shell Deployment fee: \$500.00
