


### Interlocal Cooperation Contract for Tobacco Enforcement Program Item #31

### Purpose

- Program addresses illegal sale or distribution of cigarettes, e-cigarettes, and tobacco to youth under age of 21
- Interlocal agreement allows SAPD participation in State of Texas Tobacco Enforcement Program
  - Enforcement Activity
  - Conducting buys/stings



# Background

- Texas School Safety Center at Texas State University contracts with counties and municipalities to enable local law enforcement agencies to enforce the Texas Tobacco Enforcement Program
- SAPD has participated since FY 2011
- In FY2022 SAPD performed 835 separate buy/stings at a reimbursement rate of \$125 per sting, with total revenue of \$104,375

## Program Results – Contract 2022

TOTAL	835	46	\$104,375

#### Program Award 2023 & Recommendation

- Program Period: December 2022 to August 2023
- Contract amount \$112,500
  - \$125 per Buy/Sting
  - Maximum of 900 stings
- Staff recommends approval of the execution of this contract and acceptance upon award.
