Grant Summary

- Purpose
 - Reduce alcohol-related traffic crashes and subsequent fatalities and injuries
 - Public Education and information campaigns
- Period: October 2022 to September 2023
- Grant Award - \$50,000
 - In-kind match of \$12,500
- Funds overtime to resources dedicated to augment SAPD's efforts to reduce the incidence of DWI

DWI Grant Enforcement – FY 2022



Activity	FY 2022 (Oct to Sept)
DWI Arrests	38
Felony Arrests	25
Citations Issued	213
Warnings Issued	514
Vehicle Stops	657
Personnel Hours	525

Grant Award

- \$50,000 from TxDOT for DWI traffic enforcement on an overtime basis to help augment the SAPD's efforts to reduce the incidence of DWI
- \$12,500 In-Kind Match
 - Vehicle Cost such as fuel and maintenance
 - Personnel Cost to manage grant
