Background

- Triple P – Positive Parenting Program is an evidence-based approach of positive parenting designed to prevent child abuse and strengthen family relationships.
- Program participant data provided by AVANCE, P.E.A.C.E. Initiative, and United Way of San Antonio and Bexar County to Metro Health's Violence Prevention program will identify gaps in coverage, and measure the reach, scope, and impact of Triple P programming in the San Antonio community.



Fiscal Impact

- Term: October 1, 2022 through September 30, 2023, with the option to renew for two additional one-year terms.
- Amount: No cost to Metro Health.
- There is no impact to the General Fund.



Recommendation

- Staff recommends City Council approve agreements related to Triple P participant data.
