### Call to Order / Roll Call

#### 3. River Walk Capital Improvements Fund Update

Janet Cruz, CCDO Fiscal Manager presented River Walk Capital Improvement Fund update. Current revenue is \$494,692 and there are \$2.1 million in encumbered expenses for capital projects. Collections are back on schedule and the year-end balance is projected at \$538,573.

#### 4. Overview of Completed River Walk Work

Mike Beaty from Beaty Palmer Architects informed the board that the River Walk CIP Phase VI is complete. Public Works staff and the contractor are working on closing out the project. Mr. Riley spoke in favor of future funding of work in the river walk master plan that has remained unfunded.

## 5. Update on River Walk Survey

Cynthia Martinez, board liaison, reported that the River Walk visitor and River Walk stakeholder surveys were released the week of May 20, 2022, on the SA Speak Up website. The Visit San Antonio River Walk staff has assisted with distributing the QR code to their membership; however, participation is low. Cynthia will work with CCDO staff to develop and implement a marketing plan for the surveys. An update will be provided at the next meeting.

## 6. Fund Request

Robert Rinn discussed the request funding in the amount not to exceed \$215,880 from the River Walk Capital Improvement funds for maintenance of River Walk access elevators at Presa and Crockett streets. Mr. Riley made a motion to approve this funding request which was seconded by John Jacks. The motion passed unanimously.
