

Background



- In partnership with Centro, CCDO sponsored a placemaking process with Market Square stakeholders to create a plan for Gateway Plaza located at the IH-35 underpass.
- In 2021, Project for Public Spaces, Inc. with funding from Bayer HealthCare LLC and its brand Claritin, awarded the City of San Antonio a \$100,000 *Clarity Parks Project Grant*.
- The project cost surpassed the generous grant provided by Claritin, however, UTSA and the 80 | 20 Foundation have stepped forward to provide additional support for the project.

Project Design



- The Clarity Grants program is focused on creating youth oriented outdoor public spaces or improvements.
- Project components include:
 - Half court basketball
 - Ping pong tables
 - Columns wrapped with wood decking to create seating areas; benches; and picnic tables
 - Swing chairs and tables
 - Movie/projection wall
 - Plantings
 - Colorful street-bond coating
 - Murals on overpass columns to be provided by the Department of Arts & Culture

Project Details









- The 80 | 20 Foundation will provide \$38,000 in grant funding and an additional \$12,000 in furniture and equipment that will help defer project costs.
- UTSA will provide \$46,000 in grant funding.
- The area is owned by TXDOT and COSA must execute an agreement to deliver and maintain these enhancements.
