ORDINANCE

**APPROVING A CONTRACT WITH CALDWELL
COUNTRY CHEVROLET, LLC, TO PROVIDE NINE
REPLACEMENT POLICE PATROL VEHICLES FOR THE
SAN ANTONIO POLICE DEPARTMENT FOR A TOTAL
COST OF \$447,260.00. FUNDING IS AVAILABLE FROM
THE FY 2023 EQUIPMENT RENEWAL AND
REPLACEMENT FUND BUDGET.**

WHEREAS, an offer was submitted by Caldwell Country Chevrolet, LLC, through the Texas Local Government Purchasing Cooperative (a.k.a. the “Buyboard”), to provide the City with nine replacement Police Pursuit Chevrolet Tahoe patrol vehicles for the San Antonio Police Department for a total cost of \$447,260.00; and

WHEREAS, this purchase meets the requirements under the terms of the Texas Local Government Purchasing Cooperative agreement adopted by the City of San Antonio by Ordinance No. 97097 on January 30, 2003; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The offer from Caldwell Country Chevrolet, LLC, to provide the City of San Antonio with nine replacement Police Pursuit Chevrolet Tahoe patrol vehicles for the San Antonio Police Department for a total cost of \$447,260.00 is hereby accepted, subject to and contingent upon the deposit of all required bonds, performance deposits, insurance certificates and endorsements. The bid tabulation and contract are attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Exhibit I**.

SECTION 2. Funding for this ordinance in the amount of \$446,860.00 is available in Fund 72001000, Cost Center 3503200001 and General Ledger 5709080 as part of the Fiscal Year 2023 Adopted Budget approved by City Council.

SECTION 3. Funding for this ordinance in the amount of \$400.00 is available in Fund 72001000, Cost Center 3503200001 and General Ledger 5201040 as part of the Fiscal Year 2023 Adopted Budget approved by City Council.

SECTION 4. Payment is authorized to Caldwell Country Chevrolet, LLC, and should be encumbered with a purchase order.

SECTION 5. The financial allocations in this ordinance are subject to approval by the Deputy Chief Financial Officer, City of San Antonio. The Deputy Chief Financial Officer may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund

Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this ordinance.

SECTION 6. This ordinance is effective immediately upon passage by eight or more affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective on the tenth day after passage.
