ORDINANCE

ORDINANCE APPROVING AN ADVANCE FUNDING AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO AND THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (TXDOT) AND AUTHORIZING PAYMENT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$132,000.00 PAYABLE TO TXDOT FOR THE HIGHWAY GUIDE SIGN REPLACEMENT ALONG US 90 AND SH 151 WITH NEW "HISTORIC OLD HWY 90" SIGNAGE. FUNDING IS AVAILABLE FROM FY 2023 CITY COUNCIL DISTRICT 6 OPERATING BUDGET.

WHEREAS, on February 10, 2022, City Council approved a street name change of Enrique M. Barrera Parkway to Historic Old Hwy 90 through Ordinance 2022-02-10-0097; and

WHEREAS, as part of this Advance Funding Agreement, the City will provide TxDOT with funding in the amount of \$132,000.00 to replace the existing highway guide signs along US 90 and SH 151 to reflect the Historic Old Hwy 90 street name change; and

WHEREAS, TxDOT will manage and oversee all work, including design and construction. TxDOT will also be responsible for cost overruns; and

WHEREAS, TxDOT currently has an active project along US 90 and intends on utilizing the contractor constructing this project for execution of the work if the City approves and executes the Advanced Funding Agreement before the TxDOT project is complete; and

WHEREAS, the estimated completion of the highway guide signs replacement by December 2023; NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager or designee, or the Director of the Public Works Department or designee, is authorized to execute an Advance Funding Agreement between the City of San Antonio and the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) and accept grant funding in the amount of \$132,000.00 for the Highway Guide Sign Replacement. A copy of the funding agreement in substantially final form is attached as **Exhibit A**.

SECTION 2. Funding in the amount of \$132,000.00 for this ordinance is available in Fund 11001000, Cost Center 0106010001 and General Ledger 5406539 as part of the Fiscal Year 2023 Adopted Budget approved by City Council.

SECTION 3. Payment is authorized to Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) and should be encumbered with a purchase order.

SECTION 4: The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Deputy Chief Financial Officer, City of San Antonio. The Deputy Chief Financial Officer may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific Fund Numbers, Project Definitions, WBS Elements, Internal Orders, Fund Centers, Cost Centers, Functional Areas, Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. This ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
