ORDINANCE

**APPROVING AN INTERLOCAL COOPERATION
CONTRACT BETWEEN THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF
PUBLIC SAFETY AND THE SAN ANTONIO POLICE
DEPARTMENT FOR REIMBURSEMENT OF UP TO
\$742,694.00 FOR EQUIPMENT AND SERVICES IN
CONNECTION WITH THE TEXAS ANTI-GANG
PROGRAM AND AUTHORIZING A PERSONNEL
COMPLEMENT OF ONE POSITION.**

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WHEREAS, the Texas Anti-Gang Center is funded by the Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division, to support federal, state and local law enforcement partnerships within the San Antonio Metropolitan area to combat gang violence and organized crime.

WHEREAS, the Texas Department of Public Safety (DPS) is the fiscal agent for this program, and this ordinance will allow the San Antonio Police Department (SAPD) to be reimbursed in an amount up to \$742,694.00 for SAPD expenditures including security access control, information technology support, cable services, equipment, administration of the program, overtime and one crime analyst position.

WHEREAS, SAPD will invoice the DPS on the monthly reimbursable amount for these costs, which will be paid by DPS; and

WHEREAS, such an agreement is authorized by Chapter 791 of the Texas Government Code;
NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager or designee, or the Chief of the San Antonio Police Department or designee, is hereby authorized to execute the interlocal cooperation contract with DPS attached hereto as **Exhibit A**, or a contract that is substantially the same as that attached hereto.

SECTION 2. Funds generated by this ordinance will be deposited into the General Fund No. 29616005 and Internal Order No. 217000000135.

SECTION 3. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance, may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.
